

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING PROPOSED ADOPTION
OF SCHOOL FACILITIES FEE NEXUS STUDY AND INCREASED SCHOOL FACILITIES
FEES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Delano Union School District ("District") will hold a Public Hearing at its Regular Meeting to be held on June 13, 2022 beginning at 5:00p.m. to allow for public comment prior to consideration of its adoption of the impact fee nexus study entitled *Residential and Commercial/Industrial Development School Fee Justification Study* ("Study") dated May 5, 2022 prepared by Cooperative Strategies and adoption of increased school facilities fees on residential, commercial, and industrial construction within the District based on the Study. The proposed increased fees will be levied for the purpose of funding the construction and reconstruction of school facilities necessary to maintain current levels of educational services to children in the District.

Notice of Teleconferencing Pursuant to Gov Code Section 54953 (e). The Board will conduct this meeting via teleconference (via call-in or internet-based service). This meeting will be accessible to members of the public and public comments will be allowed at appropriate times. All persons are encouraged to participate in the public hearing and will be given an opportunity to be heard.
