## Williams Uniform Complaint Procedure Form For Education Code, Section 35186 Complaints

Education Code (EC) Section 35186 creates a procedure for the filing of complaints concerning deficiencies related to instructional materials, conditions of facilities that are not maintained in a clean or safe manner or in good repair, including emergency or urgent facilities conditions that pose a threat to the health and safety of students or staff, or teacher vacancy or misassignment. The complaint and response are public documents as provided by law. Complaints may be filed anonymously. However, if you wish to receive a response to your complaint, you must provide the contact information below:

Textbooks and Instructional Materials: (Education Code 35186; 5CCR 4681) A student, including an English learner, does not have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials or state-adopted or district-adopted textbooks or other required instructional materials to use in class. A student does not have access to textbooks or instructional materials to use at home or after school. This does not require two sets of textbooks or instructional materials for each student. Textbooks or instructional materials are in poor or unusable condition, have missing pages, or are unreadable due to damage. A student was provided photocopied sheets from only a portion of a textbook or instructional materials to address a shortage of textbooks or instructional materials. 2. Teacher Vacancy or Misassignment (Education Code 35186: 5 CCR 4652) A semester begins and a teacher vacancy exists. A teacher vacancy is a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of the school year for an entire year or, if the position is for a one-semester course, a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of a semester for an entire semester. (5 CCR 4600) A teacher who lacks credentials or training to teach English learners is assigned to teach a class with one or more English learners in the П This does not relieve the district from complying with state or federal law regarding teachers of English Learners. A teacher is assigned to teach a class for which the teacher lacks subject matter competency. 3. Facility Conditions (Education Code 17592.72, 35186, 35292.5; 5 CCR 4683) A condition exists that poses an emergency or urgent threat to the health or safety of students or staff while at school, including gas leaks; П nonfunctioning heating, ventilation, fire sprinklers or air-conditioning systems; electrical power failure; major sewer line stoppage; major pest or vermin infestation; broken windows or exterior doors or gates that will not lock and that pose a security risk; abatement of hazardous

materials previously undiscovered that pose an immediate threat to students or staff; structural damage creating a hazardous or
