Child Development Teacher

Brief Description of Job:

Provide instruction to children and may supervise associate teacher, assistant and aide.

Administrative Relationship

Site Supervisor/Program Director with supervision and evaluation by Master Teacher, Coordinator, and/or Director.

TRAINING AND/OR CREDENTIALS

Education:

Must hold a valid California Child Development Permit, 24 units in early childhood education (ECE) or child development completed at an accredited or approved college or university, including core courses and 16 general education (GE) units.

Alternative Qualifications: A.A. or higher in ECE/CD or related field with 3 semester units, supervised field experience in ECE setting.

Experience: 175 days of three (3) plus hours per day within four (4) years.

Five Year Renewal Requirement: 105 hours of professional growth

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE POSITION:

1. Knows objectives of program, plans and provides age-appropriate activities in component areas of educational development; cognitive, physical, social, creative, health and nutrition education, as well as parent involvement.
2. Becomes involved in the children's work and play throughout the day by talking, interacting, and working with the children.
3. Develops and implements conflict management and problem-solving strategies with children.
4. Accepts the child's current method and level of communication while supporting growth and development of language.
5. Provides a continuous evaluation of children's needs and spends time daily planning activities to meet these needs and regularly meets with appropriate staff to discuss the children and the program.
6. Conducts parent conferences concerning progress of children.
7. Assists with parent education, techniques to use for reinforcing school activities at home, and information regarding community resources for parents.
8. Maintains-up-to date eligibility and attendance records on children and/or families.

9. Orders supplies and instructional materials.
10. Incorporated within one or more of the previously mentioned essential functions of this job description are the following essential physical requirements.

1. Seldom = Less than 25 % 3. Often = 51 - 75 %
2. Occasional = 25 - 50 % 4. Very Frequent = 76% and above

- 3 a. Ability to work at a desk, conference table or in meetings of various configurations.
3 b. Ability to stand for extended periods of time.
4 c. Ability to see for purposes of reading laws and codes, rules and policies and other printed matter and observing students.
4 d. Ability to hear and understand speech at normal levels.
4 e. Ability to communicate so others will be able to clearly understand a normal conversation.
4 f. Ability to bend and twist, stoop, kneel, run and crawl.
1 g. Ability to lift at least 40 lbs.
1 h. Ability to carry at least 40 lbs.
