SUGGESTIONS FOR SUCCESS

Substituting is a new challenge daily. Below are some valuable suggestions for you to guarantee a successful assignment.

1. Arrive early to familiarize yourself with the:
 - * lesson plans
 - * school site and classroom
 - * special events of the day
 - * discipline plan of the school
2. Meet the principal and other key staff. Ask who to call if you need assistance.
3. Discipline and effective classroom management is key to your success and student safety.

Never use any type of corporal punishment on a child.
Always call the office if you need assistance.
4. If possible, leave a written note for the teacher. It may be brief, but it should communicate how the day went, what was covered, and which student was or was not cooperative!
5. Dress for success and respect. Our students know that substitutes are “guests” on our campuses. It is important to be appropriately attired for the important job you have to perform.
6. Please be respectful to students, staff, and parents. You are an important person and you represent the district in all you say and do.
