Oral Language Coach Duties

- Carefully review and follow the KCSOS Official Rules.
- Assist students with the selection of appropriate literature pieces that meet all KCSOS guidelines.
- Get principal's approval on all selections.
- Give each student a typed copy of his or her piece.
- Help students highlight their lines.
- Assist students with the memorization of pieces.
- Demonstrate appropriate changes in voice tone and speaking rate to interpret the selection.
- Aid students in adding appropriate gestures and movements to their performances.
- Practice with students to prepare for the Oral Language Festival.
- Schedule for students to perform in front of various audiences, such as in classrooms in front of the office office staff, etc.
- Submit paperwork on time to register for the DUSD Oral Language Festival.
- Coaches are responsible for submitting scripts to Lea Cantu for those selected to advance to the Kern County Oral Language Festival.
- Provide additional support to students advancing to the Kern County Oral Language Festival by continuing to practice and improve on performances.
